

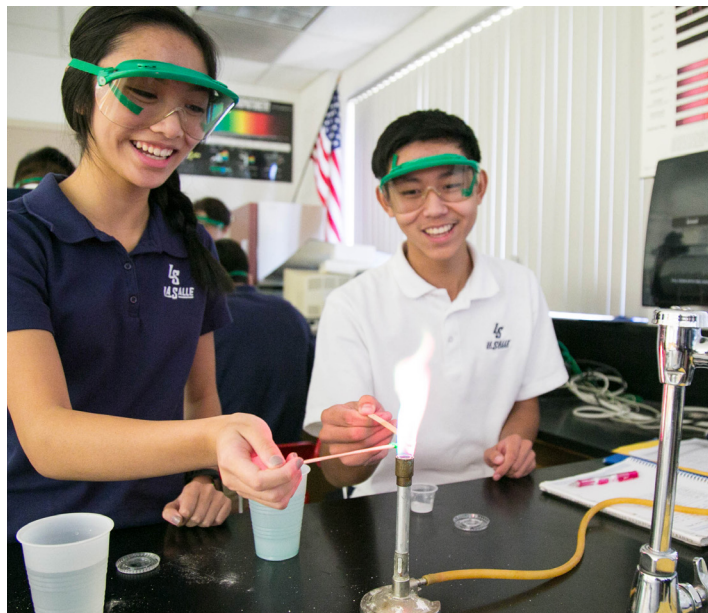
Science

Science Curriculum

La Salle offers a full range of college preparatory and Advanced Placement (AP) science classes in the areas of biology, chemistry, and physics. Elective classes include:

- Sports Medicine

- Ethics in Medicine

Our classes include hands-on, investigative lab activities in all available courses. We encourage our students to challenge themselves by taking honors and advanced courses throughout their tenures at La Salle.



Freshman Curriculum at La Salle

Our freshman science students enroll in college preparatory or honors biology. Students may be offered placement in Honors Biology based on their HSPT scores and 7th and 8th grade transcripts.



Science Clubs at La Salle

La Salle students enjoy engaging in a wide variety of clubs on campus, including Science Outreach Club. Our students have opportunities to work as mentors with middle school students and take part in science and technology projects.

In addition, qualified students may join the Science National Honor Society (SNHS). SNHS students study advanced science courses in their junior and senior years and participate in several science-oriented service projects.
