The World Languages Department focuses on the practice of comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. All courses develop the appreciation of culture, geography, history, and regional variations of the French, Spanish, and Chinese speaking people. Students use technology to enhance their language acquisition at all five levels of instruction using educational videos, digital books, and audio recordings.

Each Spring, students have the opportunity to test into honors courses. Additionally, advanced Spanish students may join the Spanish National Honors Society, which provides further appreciation of Spanish language and culture.
