First Day of School Schedule - August 16, 2021

La Salle will be dividing the first day of school into designated times for both lower classmen and upper classmen on August 16th to avoid long-term close contact between large groups of students.

Freshmen-Sophomores will begin check in at 7:30am, and will be dismissed from school at 10:30am.

Juniors-Seniors will begin check in at 10:30am, and will be dismissed from school at 1:30pm.

The students will attend a welcome rally, learn about the new uniform and accountability protocols and also take their school pictures during their three-hour time slot.

Back to School COVID-19 Testing

All members of the school community must provide a negative COVID-19 test result within 72 hours of your first day of school in order to come onto

campus. The first day of school for incoming freshman and transfer students is on August 12, all other returning students on Monday, August 16th.

La Salle will provide the following testing dates and times free of charge on campus for all participants:

August 9th between 2:00pm-4:00pm in the atrium: Incoming Freshmen and Transfer Students (or those assisting with The New Student Orientation)

2:00-2:45pm	Last Name A-G
2:45-3:30pm	Last Name H-P
3:30-4:00pm	Last Name Q-Z

August 13th between 10:00am-2:30pm in the atrium: Sophomores-Seniors

10:00am-11:30am	Sophomores
1:30am-1:00pm	Juniors
1:00pm-2:30pm	Seniors

Testing Instructions:

- Check in at the gym entrance using the MyMedBot app and report to the library using the 3rd floor outdoor stairwell (there will be guides and signage posted).
- Students will form a line outside at the library entrance.
- Please be sure you bring this [completed form](#), a copy of your parent's photo id, and a copy of your health insurance card.
- When called, students will go to a private study room to answer questions regarding previous health conditions administered by a physician on an ipad. La Salle will be using Capstone Clinical Laboratories to administer the Covid-19 tests. *The testing company we will be using, Capstone Clinical Laboratories, will ask for insurance information, but you will not be billed directly, and the cost will still be free if you do not have insurance. Capstone Clinical Laboratories works with insurance companies and the state government to fully cover the cost of the test, regardless of your insurance status.
- Once the student has completed the verbal questionnaire, they will then complete a nose-swab test near the amphitheater.
- Students will exit out of the building using the double doors near the band room. The lower parking lot will not be open for parking due to construction.

Volunteer and Visitor COVID-19 Protocols

At this time, testing will only be required for anyone that spends more than 15 minutes consecutively with students in close contact. A screening at the front entrance to assist the Covid Compliance Officers with contact tracing will still be required for all visitors and volunteers. This includes filling out a questionnaire using the school's QR code and temperature checks for each individual visiting. This screening is the same one that we have used in the past, and will be monitored closely.
